

## GUIDE TO FEES

## PACIFIC COAST SWIMMING MONTHLY GROUP FEES

Group fees are paid per month by post-dated cheques submitted at registration for October through June; we require payment of the September (half-month fees) and July amounts dated at the time of registration. The most senior swimmer in your family pays 100% of the applicable PCS monthly fees; additional family swimmers pay 80% of applicable group fees.

Note that as your swimmer moves through groups, monthly fees will change. When this occurs, you will not be required to submit additional cheques, but the additional amount will be added to your monthly bill. Swim meet entries, team travel, accommodation and equipment costs, and the like, are additional to group fees, and will be billed to your account as they occur.

We require one month's notice should you decide to withdraw from swimming – your July fees, which are paid in September. Please notify us by June 1st if you intend to swim through June but not in July – your account will be credited one month's fees.

## SWIM BC ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEES

Swim BC ([www.swim.bc.ca](http://www.swim.bc.ca)) is the governing body for competitive year-round swimming in British Columbia. Some Swim BC annual registration fees are reduced on April 1. Families with 3 or more swimmers may apply through the PCS registrar to Swim BC for a discount of \$10.00 for the 3rd swimmer and \$20.00 for each additional swimmer in one family.

**At the time of registration all swimmers *must* pay the annual Swim BC registration fees applicable to their swimming level. Please ask your coach or PCS General Manager Mark Lancaster if you are unsure which registration category applies to your swimmer ([mlancaster@pacificcoastswimming.com](mailto:mlancaster@pacificcoastswimming.com); 727-9243).**

- ✓ D group swimmers should register Minimum Training, Ten & under, or Provincial, depending on their age at registration, how many hours they train per week, and how many meets they anticipate swimming.
- ✓ LF3 swimmers will compete in sanctioned time trials – they should register in the 10 & under or Minimum Training category depending on their age at registration.
- ✓ LF1, LF2, Tiny Tykes and Fast Friday participants are Sessional swimmers.
- ✓ Stroke & Fitness participants may be Sessional swimmers, depending on age at registration.
- ✓ Sessional registrants who compete in *any* sanctioned time trial or meet are required to upgrade their registration category.
- ✓ Swimmers are also required to upgrade their registration category through the year as training or competitive standards are met. For example, swimmers who qualify with their first Age Group National time will be upgraded to National registration.

<b>National</b>	\$169.00	Swimmers with Age Group National, Western, or Senior National qualifying times; University swimmers who compete in any SNC meet (Bell Grand Prix, Westerns, Senior Nationals) during the University season must also register in the National category
<b>Provincial</b>	\$127.00	Competitive swimmers aged 11 years or over as of November 1st
<b>Ten &amp; Under</b>	\$83.00	Competitive swimmers aged 10 or under as of October 31st
<b>Minimum Training</b>	\$60.00	Limit four hours of water training per week and a maximum of four Swim BC sanctioned events – must upgrade to appropriate category when either restriction exceeded. Minimum age 11 at registration.
<b>Pre-Competitive</b>	\$38.00	Learn-to-compete programs - may not compete in any sanctioned meet but may participate in unsanctioned meets; maximum age 17 at registration
<b>Sessional</b>	\$16.00	Learn to swim and school programs; may not compete in any pre-competitive or competitive meet; maximum age 17 at registration

In this case, the "July" cheque is the last month of the session, and the number of intervening cheques will change as well.
