Seasons Greetings to everyone at Pacific Coast Swimming! Another two months have been completed in the swim schedule for this year.

PCS Awards Night - Once again we all had a lot of fun, and congratulations to our annual trophy winners: Kristina Philips and Evan Letkeman (10 & Under), Alyssa Bakken and Tyler Smith (11/12), Nicole Crawford and David Vizsolyi (13/14), Hollis Roth and Greer Jacks (15-17) and Stephanie Dixon and Nathan O'Brien (Senior).



November saw continued training and a number of meets. Lightning Fast, D and C groups attended our own All Level Freestyle Challenge Meet and swimmers improved their times by leaps and bounds. There were several highlights at the Pacific Cup, including the 100 Fly, where Julia Schmidt went a 1:18.48 in finals, and Nick Sinclair swam a 1:12.97. Karley Stutzel and Dave Creel, with PCS head coach and Canadian Open Water Head Coach Ron Jacks, attended the FINA World Open Water Championships in Dubai in the United Arab Emirates. Dave swam to 17th and 18<sup>th</sup> in the 5K and 10K races. Karley placed 7<sup>th</sup> in the 5km swim, 17<sup>th</sup> in the 10km, and 9<sup>th</sup> in the 25km competition.



November also saw the Canadian Short Course Open Championships, where Jesse Jacks won Gold in the Men's 200 Butterfly, and Mackenzie Downing took Silver in the Women's 200 Butterfly. At the 2004 Canadian Swimming Awards, hosted by Swimming Canada and the Canadian Swim Coaches and Teachers Association, and UVPCS swimmers and coaches picked up a number of awards. Karley Stutzel was named the 2004 Canadian Open Swimmer of the Year. Nathan O'Brien won the 2004 Canadian Male Backstroke Swimmer of the Year for his 200m Gold at the 2004 Canadian Olympic Trials this past summer. UVPCS Head Coach Ron Jacks won the 2004 Canadian Open Water Coach of the Year Award. Jacks was also honoured for his work with reigning UVic Athlete of the Year and eight-time 2004 Paralympic medalist Stephanie Dixon. Jacks picked up a Petro Canada Coaching Excellence Award and a Speedo Domestic Excellence Award for coaching a reigning National Champion. UVPCS Coach Rod Barratt was also honoured with a Speedo Domestic Excellence Award.

In December, our youngest swimmers participated in our second Time Trial and we were truly impressed by their progress in just two months. Our Christmas Cracker Invitational went off with a "bang" this year with eighteen clubs attending, and fast swimming accompanied the Christmas theme. Almost all swimmers posted best times and several milestone swims were noted. Congratulations to Alyssa Bakken, who set two age group (12 and under) Provincial records, in the 100 and 200 Backstroke. David Vizsolyi, Alison Hooper and Jovanna Ruffalo are all newly qualified for Youth Nationals; Nick Sinclair is a new Club National gualifier; and Jacob McKee qualified for AAAs. Many, many thanks to everybody who helped make this meet such a success!
