SWIM MEET NEWS... Olympics and Paralympics

The summer season proved very exciting for Nathan O'Brien and Stephanie Dixon. At the August Olympics, Nathan was one of two Canadian swimmers to swim to best times; he finished 10th in heats and 14th in semi-finals for 200 Backstroke; he also set a personal best time in the 200 Butterfly. Following the September Paralympics, Stephanie is on her way home with one Gold Medal, six Silvers and one Bronze Medal. The 100 Backstroke Gold was a World Record, at 1:10.01; Stephanie also set three Canadian Records and completed a sweep of 8 medals in 8 events. Congratulations to Stephanie and Nathan for their Olympic and Paralympic successes and best wishes for many more in the future!

International Open Water Swimming

Karley Stutzel and Dave Creel attended the Speedo "10K for the USA" Open Water Meet in Atlantic City in mid-September. Karley finished in 5th place with only 0.6 seconds separating her from the third place finisher. Dave also swam to a fifth place finish, in another tight race for the top six spots. Dave and Karley both qualified for the Canadian Open Water Team traveling to Abu Dhabi in the United Arab Emirates for the FINA World Open Water Championships this November.
