*Session lengths are approximate ELIGIBILITY

- All swimmers must be registered with a Swim BC, SNC, USS or other FINA recognized club.
- As of the entry deadline, athletes must have attained at least ONE 2010-2011 BC AA short course or long course qualifying time in an appropriately sanctioned competition, AND must not have attained a AAA time in their age group.
 - a. 10&U Swimmers must have attained at least <u>one</u> of the SC or LC SwimStars qualifying times to participate in the 10&U SwimStars program
 - b. 10&U swimmers who do not have a SwimStars QT, but do have an 11&U "AA" time (and no 11&U AAA times) may enter and compete as 11&U at this meet.
- 3. Age groups for finals will be 11&U, 12, 13, 14, 15&O
 - a. Ages with fewer than 8 finalists in an event may be combined with other under-subscribed ages
- 4. Swimmer age is as of the first day of competition.
- 5. Swimmers cannot swim in an "older" age if they have a "AAA" time in their current age, EXCEPT for swimmers who have a birthday (and thus change ages) between June 24 and July 7.

- a. Swimmers in this situation are dequalified from this meet if they have a "AAA" time in the older age group.
- 6. Converted entry times are <u>NOT</u> accepted; any SCM entry times will be converted by meet management for seeding purposes.
- 7. All entry times will be validated against the Swimming Canada results database

NON-QUALIFIED SWIMS

- Every swimmer with at least one qualifying time may enter up to EIGHT individual events.
- For 400 freestyle and 400 IM, meet management reserves the right to swim any/all non-qualified entries in overflow heats to be run Senior-seeded, fastest to slowest, at the conclusion of the heats provided desired timelines can be met. That is, there is no guarantee that non-qualified 400m entries will swim.
 - a. In this case, non-qualified 400m entrants will be given the opportunity to enter a 50, 100, or 200m event.
- 3. Non-qualified entries in the 800 and 1500 will not be accepted.
- "NT" entries will <u>not</u> be accepted in any events; swimmers must have a valid proveable entry time in each event they enter.

10&U SwimStars Program

- Awards in the SwimStars program will be determinted by cumulative time in all six SwimStars events (heats/finals of 100 free, 100 back, 50 breast, 50 fly; timed final of 200 IM, 400Fr)
- Participants in SwimStars program may enter up to two additional 11&U events, provided they have at least one 11&U "AA" time and no "AAA" times.
 - a. 10&U SwimStars cannot enter 11&U 100 Free, 100 Back, 200 IM, or 400 Free
- Swimmers who are disqualified in an event will be given a provisional time of the slowest time plus ten seconds.
 - a. Swimmers who do not swim an event will be given no time and will be ineligible for awards.

ENTRIES

- Individual entries are limited to a maximum of eight per swimmer
- 2. Proof of time is required for all relay entries. Please email proof of time report for your club to entries coordiator,

- 3. CUSTOM TIMES ARE NOT ACCEPTED.
- Entries must include relay names along with the relay entries.
 Relay swimmers may be changed at the meet.
- 5. Entry fees are \$8.00 per individual event and \$9.00 per relay event, plus a \$4/swimmer SwimBC Provincial Team Fee.
- 6. Cheques payable to: Liquid Lightning Swim Club
- 7. All fees MUST be paid prior to the start of the meet.
- 8. Entries must be uploaded to Swimming Canada http://meetlist.notlong.com website.
- Please include the proper contact name, phone number, and email address when uploading entries.

ENTRY DEADLINE: TUESDAY, JUNE 14, 2011

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SCRATCHES - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- There is no scratch penalty for no-shows, step downs and unexcused incomplete swims in prelims.
- For all finals sessions and timed final events, no-shows, step downs and unexcused incomplete swims will all be considered a late scratch.
- The initial scratch deadline for finals each night will be 30
 minutes following the completion of morning preliminaries,
 excluding any 800/1500 or "overflow" heats
- The last scratch deadline for finals will be 30 minutes prior to the start of the finals session.
- 5. Late scratches (as defined above) from finals will be subject to the late scratch penalty of \$20, plus removal from all other events, including relays, on that day. In addition, no other member of the offending swimmer's team shall compete until the \$20 penalty has been paid.

GENERAL

- This meet will observe rules as outlined in the current SNC Rulebook and Swim BC Tech Guide.
- 3. Deck entries and Exhibition Swims are not permitted.
- 4. There will be no time trials.
- SNC warm-up procedures apply. No diving into pool until sprint lanes are announced approximately 30 minutes prior to the conclusion of warm-ups.
- Preliminaries and finals will be swum in the event order as outlined in the meet event list, except for relays during prelims on Friday, which will swim prior to 800/1500m events.
- All events will be senior-seeded slowest to fastest for prelims, fastest three heats circle-seeded, with ages broken out for finals.
- 8. The 400m finals will be swum as 11-12, 13-14 with four swimmers from each age in the final. (e.g. the 11-12 final will feature four 11-year-olds and four 12-year-olds)
 - a. The 15&O 400m finals will be swum with the top eight 15&O swimmers advancing to the final.
- Coaches are asked to check in with the Meet Manager immediately upon arrival to pay entry fees, pick up Meet Package and receive information regarding any changes.
- 10. A coaches' meeting will be held 10 minutes prior to the start of heats on Friday and as necessary.
- 11. In the event that warm-up lanes are unavailable in the facility, there will be scheduled breaks during the meet to give swimmers an opportunity to warm-up and/or cool down.
- 12. Should it become necessary to change warm-up and/or starting times, coaches will be notified as soon as possible.
- 13. Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet.

800 - 1500 Freestyle

- The 800 & 1500 freestyle events will be swum as timed finals, with all qualified swimmers seeded fastest to slowest.
- All age groups will swim on Friday; however, if desired timelines on Friday cannot be met, slower qualified heats that cannot be completed on Friday will be swum on Saturday at the conclusion of prelims.
- 3. The scratch deadline for 800/1500 will be 10:00am on Friday, June 24, 2011.
- 4. Any scratches (as defined in SCRATCHES section previousy) after the 10:00am scratch deadline will be treated the same as a late scratch from finals with the same penalties.
- Awards will still be presented in the individual age categories as outlined earlier
- Meet management reserves the right to swim these events two-swimmers-per-lane.

Relays

- Only the fastest eight proved relay entries in each event will swim as timed finals at the conclusion of finals sessions. All other relay heats will swim as a timed final at the end of the preliminaries session.
 - a. If there are few entries over-and-above the top 8 per event, meet management may swim all relay entries during the finals session
- There will be no qualifying times for relays, but for seeding purposes, proof of time must accompany relay entries.
- There will be no maximum number of teams per club for relay entries.
- Only swimmers whose names appear on the meet entries shall compete in relay events.
- 5. Swimmers who will be in relays only must be listed in their club's Hytek entry file as "Relay only swimmers", and cannot have a "AAA" time. An email must also be sent to the entries coordinator notifying them of the relay-only swimmer and their SNC ID number and date of birth.
- 6. For relays seeded to be swum during prelims, the deadline for submitting swimmer names/order shall be 10:30am; for those relays in finals, the deadline shall be 30 minutes prior to the end of the finals warm-up period.
- These swimmers are subject to Swim BC Splash Fee.
- Swimmers cannot compete in a relay event in an age/age group in which they have a AAA time.

SCORING

1. There will be no team or individual scoring.

AWARDS

- Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in all individual and relay events with four or more entries.
- 2. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th places in individual events only.
