Eligibility: All swimmers must be registered with Swim BC or FINA Affiliated club. Age groups are based on the age of swimmer as of February 18, 2012. Entries limited to the team entering the 200th swimmer.

As this swim meet falls during the SwimBC blackout period, AA swimmers (those with a AA time but no AAA times) who did not attend the 2012 SwimBC AA Championships in Chilliwack are NOT eligible to participate in this meet; AA swimmers who did attend 2012 SwimBC AA Champs, though, are eligible to compete at this meet.

NOTE: 10&U swimmers are exempt from the blackout periods; for example, 10&U swimmers may compete in Regional meets during a given blackout period even if they have 11&U AA or AAA times.

Entry Fees: For Both days cost per swimmer - \$50.00 (Includes SWIM BC Splash Fee). Swimmers are limited to 8 individual events and 2 relays. Cost per relay - \$8.00
For One day only, cost per swimmer is \$30.00 (Includes SWIM BC Splash Fee). Swimmers are limited to 4 individual events and 1 relay. Cost per relay - \$8.00

Awards: Ribbons will be given out for 1st to 6th place for individual events only, and for swimmers under 15 years of age.

Meet Rules: **SNC and Swim BC rules will apply.**

- The SNC one start rule will be in effect.
- The current SNC swimsuit rule will be in effect.
- The meet will be run cardless.
- 10 & Unders will be swum separately.
- 11 & Over will be seeded together but ranked separately by age group
- Seeding will be slowest to fastest.
- All events are timed finals.

Should the need arise, meet management may limit the number of heats in some longer events, double-lane 400 Free, and/or to reschedule events based on the number of entries received. We suggest teams use the applicable BC A-standard as a cut-off when considering entries for the 400 Freestyle.

Deck Entries: Deck entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis to fill empty lanes only. Deck entries will be \$10.00 per race and swimmers may not exceed the 8 race maximum. Deck entries must include the swimmers correct nine-digit SNC ID and date of birth for those swimmers not already in the meet.

Eliminator Events:

50 Freestyle Eliminator: This event takes place on Saturday.

The top 6 male and female swimmers from the 50 freestyle will be selected. Swimmers are automatically eligible for this event when they enter the 50 freestyle. They will swim five 50's of freestyle, 3 minutes apart, with the slowest swimmer being eliminated each time.

The winner of the final 50 is the eliminator champion.

200 IM Eliminator: This event takes place on Sunday.

The top 6 male and female swimmers from the 200 IM will be selected. Swimmers are automatically eligible for this event when they enter the 200 IM. They will swim a 200 IM on 8 minutes with the slowest swimmer eliminated and the fastest swimmer selecting the stroke to drop. They will then swim a 150 in the same fashion on 6 minutes, then a 100 on 4 minutes until finally the top three will race one 50m for the championship. Each time the slowest swimmer will be eliminated, and the winner will delete one stroke until the final 50 is of one stroke only.
